- ◆ Is lacking one or both significant parental role models
- ◆ The family is economically disadvantaged
- ◆ Family is learning English as a second language
- ◆ Has exhibited delinquent behavior
- ◆ Has experienced repeated difficulties in school
- ◆ Has special physical, mental or emotional needs
- ◆ Is a drug and/or alcohol user
- ◆ Demonstrates anti-social behavior
- ◆ Is a victim of neglect or physical, sexual, or emotional abuse
- ◆ Family has significant drug or alcohol issues
- ◆ There is a history of physical, sexual, or emotional abuse in the immediate family
- ◆ A family member has been incarcerated
